Preface

After the Second Edition was published, the editor noted several items that had been inadvertently omitted. The following pages are offered as Addendum B to the **Second Edition** of the **Hetrick Family History of Sandusky Co., Ohio**.

John Nicholas Hetrick – Replacement Grave Marker

The Family History honors common ancestors, John Nicholas and Anna Catharina (Brosius) Hetrick of Northumberland, Pennsylvania. They were among the original founders of the Himmel Church in Rebuck, Pennsylvania and were laid to rest in the Himmel Cemetery. The original grave marker was moved to facilitate a church renovation project and misplaced. Jack K. Hetrick of Sunbury, Pennsylvania initiated an effort to have a new marker erected on their gravesite. A photo of the new marker is available thanks to Rob & Deborah (Barrett) Porter.

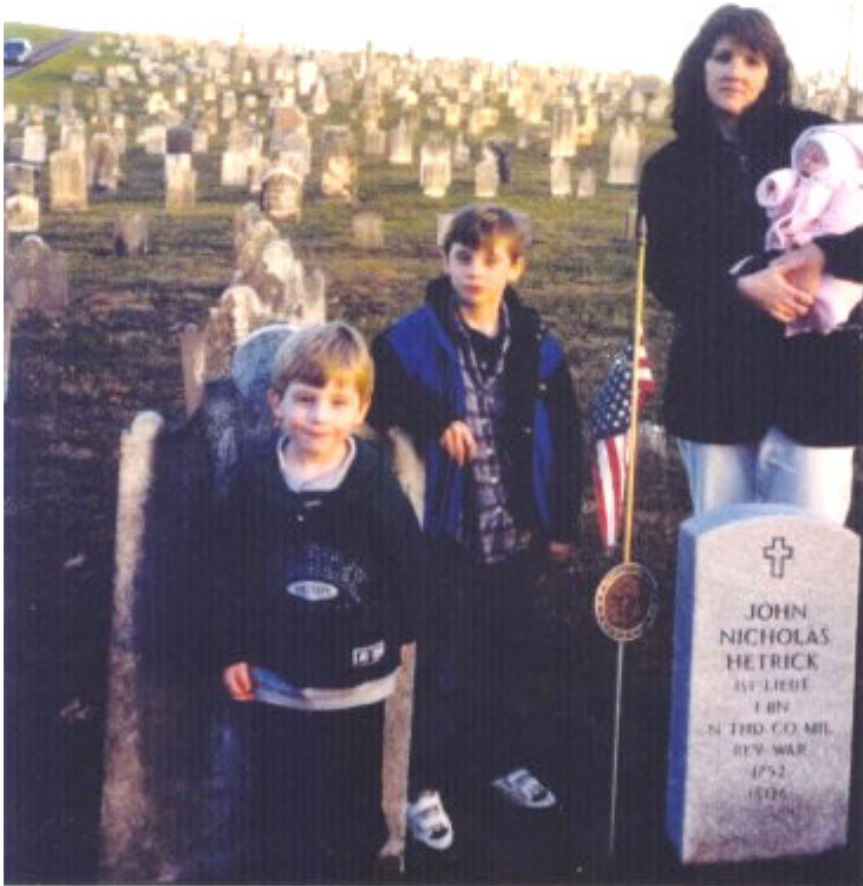


Figure 1 New Grave Marker for John Nicholas Hetrick in the Himmel Cemetery, Rebuck, Northumberland, Pennsylvania. Photo taken 1999. David, Christopher, and Deborah holding Amy Porter (6th great-granddaughter of John & Anna Catharina Hetrick).

1. **Hattie Elisa CARNICOM** was born on 4 Oct 1883 in Washington Twp., Sandusky Co., Ohio. She died on 23 Oct 1917 in Madison Twp., Sandusky Co., Ohio. She was buried on 26 Oct 1917 in West Union Cem., Gibsonburg, Ohio.

Died in childbirth. Infant also died. She is buried in SA3.

Picture of grave marker shows (1883-1917) On a photocopy of her Remembrance sheet, her birth is written as Oct.3. Her age there is listed as 34 years 20 days. Also in Vargas file are copies of her obit.

On her marriage license application (copy in Vargas file) her age is 19 on the 6 day of Oct 1902. Her parents names were given and it said she "resides at home" in Washington Township. The license was filed and recorded on 19 Dec 1902 in Wauseon, Ohio.

Hattie played the organ at Washington Chapel Methodist Church.

Hattie married **George Washington * HUMBERGER Sr.** son of Solomon H. * HUMBERGER and Hetty Ann * BURKETT on 18 Dec 1902 in Wauseon, Fulton, Ohio. George was born on 13 Sep 1880 in Washington Twp, Sandusky Co., Ohio. He died on 2 Mar 1963 in Gibsonburg, Sandusky Co., Ohio. He was buried on 5 Mar 1963 in West Union Cem., Gibsonburg, Ohio.

He was a farmer his entire life. Before his marriage, he went to Washington state to log trees for one year. He lived less than 5 miles from Hattie's family. They married, had a house in Gibsonburg and then rented a farm outside of Gibsonburg.

All of the children were born in Sandusky Co., OH. In about 1911 the couple went back to the Humberger Homestead (160 acres 2 miles E of Gibsonburg). Hattie died during child birth. Her cousin **Bess** came to help George and they later married and stayed on that farm, moving into the big house. It was here that their first three children were born.

A certified copy of George's birth certificate (see Vargas file) gives his birth date as Sept 18, but Sept 13 is correct. He is buried in SA3. His obit said he had 27 grandchildren and 21 great-grandchildren.

Also in the file is a copy of Hattie and George's wedding picture, taken 18 Dec 1902 and a copy of their marriage license application, #1053 Probate Court, Sandusky Co, OH. On this, George's birth date is 13 Sep 1880. It gives his occupation as Threshing, the names of his parents and his place of birth.

The grave marker reads 1880-1963.

George and Hattie had the following children:

- 2 M i. **Roy Calvin HUMBERGER** was born on 21 Apr 1903 in Gibsonburg, Sandusky, Ohio. He died on 5 Apr 1993 in Clyde, Sandusky Co., Ohio. He was buried on 10 Apr 1993 in West Union Cemetery, Gibsonburg, Ohio.

Roy married **Nellie Gladys BECKLEY** on 11 Apr 1927 in Maryland. Nellie was born on 1 Dec 1905 in St. Michael's, Cambria Co, PA. She died on 19 Aug 1989 in Fremont, Sandusky Co., OH. She was buried in West Union Cem, Gibsonburg, OH.

Dates from tombstone, where she was called Nellie G., and SSDI records.

Nellie was the daughter of Carrie G. GRIFFITH and Howard Wright Beckley. She was buried in plot s1-lot99 gv44.

- 3 F ii. **Helen Irene HUMBERGER** was born on 20 Jul 1905 in Washington Twp, Sandusky Co, OH. She died on 2 May 2002 in Valley View Healthcare Center, Fremont, Sandusky Co, OH. She was buried in West Union Cemetery, Madison Twp, Sandusky Co, OH.

Helen married **Nelson Bruce WEYANT** on 28 May 1927 in Fremont, Sandusky, OH. Nelson was born on 27 Nov 1900 in St. Clairsville, Bedford Co, PA. He died on 14 May 1974 in Burgoon, Sandusky Co, OH. He was buried on 17 May 1974 in West Union Cem, Gibsonburg, OH.

Called Bruce, he was the son of Harry and Daisy Weyant. He is buried in plot s3-lot223 gv5. He died at age 73. His tombstone reads "Bruce Weyant 1900-1974".

- 4 F iii. **Wilma Marie HUMBERGER** was born on 4 Jun 1908 in Washington Twp., Sandusky Co., Ohio. She died on 6 Dec 1983 in Clyde, Sandusky, Ohio. She was buried on 9 Dec 1983 in West Union Cemetery, Gibsonburg, Ohio.

Died of cancer. Buried in plots20-lot48 gv4. She may have died in a Toledo hospital.

Wilma married (1) **Bruce Beryl LING** on 16 Oct 1926 in Fremont, Sandusky Co., OH. The marriage ended in divorce. Bruce was born on 12 Jan 1901 in Tinney, Sandusky Co., OH. He died on 20 May 1964 in Gibsonburg, Sandusky Co., Ohio. He was buried on 23 May 1964 in West Union Cem, Gibsonburg, OH.

Parents Charles Elmer LING and Sarah Jeanette "Nettie" ORY. Cause of death-coronary occlusion.

Wilma married (2) **Eugene O. KIRLEY** about 1946. Eugene was born on 8 Jun 1900 in NY. He died on 5 Oct 1973 in Fremont, Sandusky, OH. He was buried on 8 Oct 1973 in West Union Cem, Gibsonburg, OH.

Died from heart attack. Buried in plot s20-lot 48 gv 3.

According to his obit, Gene was 73 and his parents were Thomas and Rose (McGinn) KIRLEY.

Wilma married (3) **Lawrence Lewis ROE** on 5 Mar 1975. Lawrence was born on 15 Feb 1905 in Bellevue, Huron Co, OH. He died on 11 Jul 2001 in Elmwood Nursing Home, Green Springs, Sandusky, OH. He was buried on 14 Jul 2001 in Greenlawn Memory Gardens, Clyde, Sandusky, OH.

Information from his obit, which appeared in The News-Messenger, Fremont, Ohio on 12 July, 2001. He was the son of Albert and Sarah (Green) ROE

- 5 F iv. **Ruth Lucile HUMBERGER** was born on 9 Jun 1910 in Washington Twp, Sandusky Co, OH. She died on 17 Jun 1999 in Middleton, NY. She was buried on 25 Jul 1999 in West Union Cem., Gibsonburg, Ohio.

She died from cancer at her daughter Mary's home in NY. Her ashes were buried in Gibsonburg the morning of the Humberger Family reunion. Tombstone-"GALBRAITH Ruth L. June 9, 1910 June 17, 1999".

Ruth married **Kenneth Kethell GALBRAITH** on 9 Jun 1933 in Toledo, Lucas, OH. Kenneth was born on 13 Sep 1907 in OH. He died on 18 Oct 1983 in Sun City, Hillsborough Co, FL. He was buried in West Union Cem, Gibsonburg, OH.

Kenneth was the son of Guy and Alma "May" Kellie (or Kelley) Galbraith.

He was found on the 1910 census in Gibsonburg with his parents, age 2, b.OH.

His tombstone reads "GALBRAITH Kenneth K. Sept. 13, 1907 Oct. 18, 1983".

- 6 F v. **Mildred Mae HUMBERGER** was born on 27 Dec 1913 in Washington Twp, Sandusky, OH. She died on 21 Mar 2000 in Toledo, Lucas, OH. She was buried on 24 Mar 2000 in West Union Cemetery, Gibsonburg, Ohio.

Mid suffered a heart attack while working outside on the farm and died during the night at Toledo Hospital. According to her obit, she was 86. "KOLKEMEYER Mildred M. 1913-2000."

Mildred married **Lawrence Edward KOLKEMEYER** on 28 May 1938 in Upper Sandusky, OH. Lawrence was born on 11 May 1910 in OH. He died on 21 Jan 1993 in Gibsonburg, Sandusky Co, OH. He was buried in West Union Cemetery, Gibsonburg, Ohio.

Lawrence was the son of Anna M. Baden and Henry C. Kolkemeyer, Jr. His father purchased the 80 acre farm on S.R.300 near Gibsonburg. At the end of WWII. Lawrence took over the farm and lived there until his death. He had Alzheimer's. Cause of death listed as cerebrovascular accident. He was buried in plot s3-lot 164 gv 1. "KOLKEMEYER Lawrence E. 1910-1993".

7 F vi. **(Living) HUMBERGER** was born Gibsonburg, Sandusky Co., Ohio.

8 M vii. **(male) HUMBERGER** was born on 23 Oct 1917 in Washington Twp, Sandusky Co, OH. He died on 23 Oct 1917 in Washington Twp, Sandusky Co, OH. He was buried in West Union Cemetery, Gibsonburg, Ohio.

He was stillborn and died with his mother, who was given too much oxygen during childbirth. Online OH Death Certificate Index for Stillborn Humbarger, vol. 2406, cert. # 67357.
